MARGINAL HIKE IN PRICE OF NON-SUBSIDIZED LPG CYLINDER

NEW DELHI: The price of non-subsidized LPG (Liquid Petroleum Gas) cylinders has been marginally increased with effect from Wednesday. In Delhi, non-subsidized LPG cylinders will costlier by Re 1. According to the ministry, the weighted price of a 14.2-kg non-subsidized gas cylinder in Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai has been increased from Rs 593 to Rs 594, from Rs 616 to Rs 620.50, from Rs 590.50 to Rs 594 and from Rs 606.50 to Rs 610.50, respectively, from July 1.
